## **MORE THAN A DOZEN FORMER PROSECUTORS ANNOUNCE SUPPORT FOR**

### **SETH WILLIAMS FOR DISTRICT ATTORNEY**

**PHILADELPHIA:** More than a dozen former Assistant District Attorneys announced their support for Seth Williams at a 2:00 PM press conference in City Hall today. The former prosecutors are endorsing Seth because they know he has the experience and vision needed to help improve safety in Philadelphia.
