CONGRESSMAN CHAKA FATTAH ENDORSES SETH WILLIAMS FOR DISTRICT ATTORNEY *Fattah Cites Seth's Leadership Experience In DA Office*

PHILADELPHIA: Congressman Chaka Fattah, representing Philadelphia and Pennsylvania's 2nd Congressional District in the U.S. House of Representatives, has added his voice to growing number of public officials endorsing Seth Williams to be Philadelphia's next District Attorney.

Congressman Fattah cited Seth's leadership experience as a supervisor in the D.A.'s office as a key factor in his endorsement: "Seth Williams is the only candidate for District Attorney who has served in a supervising capacity in the DA's office. Congressman Fattah publicly announced his endorsement of Seth at 2 PM on Saturday, May 2nd, 2009, at the Youth Study Center, located at 3232 Henry Avenue in Philadelphia.

"I am honored to have the support of Congressman Fattah," Seth said. "Chaka Fattah is one of Philadelphia's strongest advocates in the halls of Congress, and he embodies the kind of constituent-focused leadership that I intend to bring to the District Attorney's office."
