SETH WILLIAMS ENDORSED BY LIBERTY CITY
Another Major Endorsement Adds to Seth's Growing Momentum

PHILADELPHIA: District Attorney candidate Seth Williams added to his growing list of endorsements last night when Liberty City, the leading LGBT political organization in the City of Philadelphia, gave him its' backing. Liberty City has proven itself to be an integral part of successful field campaigns for the candidates it backs.

"I am extremely proud to have received Liberty City's support," said Seth today. "With their help, and the help of people across the city who realize our criminal justice system is fundamentally broken and needs reform, we can make the change we need to make every neighborhood and every community safer."

Liberty City Lesbian and Gay Democratic Club was founded in the Fall of 1994 by activists who wanted to build lesbian and gay power and involvement in the Democratic Party. Liberty City has built a list of over 30,000 LGBT voters in the Philadelphia area and 80,000 voters across the state.

Liberty City's endorsement is the latest in Seth's growing list of supporters, which includes the Fraternal Order of Police, more than a dozen former Assistant District Attorneys, 12 state elected officials, the Fraternal Order of Police Philadelphia Housing Authority, the Transportation Workers Union Local 234 and the Guardian Civic League.
